

HEAVEN'S DECREE IN ROE VERSES WADE

While in prayer in the courts of heaven, I was compelled to present before the Elders and those present the verdict of "Roe versus Wade" on abortion rights and asked for a decree from heaven on the issue.

The Elders conferred and issued a verdict. Here is the decree from the Court of Heaven.

Verdict of Heaven's Court.

"The Court of Heaven finds that the verdict of Roe versus Wade resulting in legal actions and laws regarding the unborn are unjust and that they violate the Laws of Heaven, the Constitution of America, and the rights of the unborn children. According to your own Constitution, all human beings have 'the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.' You have enthroned evil by law." (Ps 94:20).

Findings of Heaven's Court.

"This court finds in favor of the plaintiff here represented to wit: the unborn children of America. The court decrees the overturning of the laws and legal actions based on the decision in Roe versus Wade. The court further upholds the decrees of your President (Trump) given at the annual march for life in which he stated: 'We understand the truth that every child is a precious and a sacred gift from God.'" (127:3) "Together, we must protect, cherish, and defend the dignity and sanctity of every human life. When we see the image of a baby in the womb, we glimpse the majesty of God's creation. And as the Bible tells us each person is 'wonderfully made'. (Ps 139:14) Together, we are the voice of the voiceless. Every human life, born or unborn, is made in the holy image of God.'" (Gen. 1:26). The court agrees with this declaration.

Actions inferred

The Church must declare what is done in heaven will be done on earth. (Matt. 6:10). We will continue to pray, declare and speak into the issue of the rights of the unborn by letting those in government know of our support for the unborn and desire to see Roe Verses Wade overturned. We will not despise any of these little ones as Jesus said for their angels stand before the face of God. (Matt. 18:10). Let us declare that God will send the message of Elijah and turn the hearts of the fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to the fathers. (Mal. 4:5-6).

Repentance is remembering God and turning back to Him that our sins (and sinful actions) may be wiped out, and the times of refreshing may come to restore

us. (Acts 3:19) Repentance and asking forgiveness is a part of returning to God, *“The redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins.”* (Isa. 59:20) In the previous verse, God says He will lift up a standard (hedge) when the enemy comes in like a flood. (Verse 19). God sends His angels to watch over His Word and protect His people. We need to declare a hedge over the unborn children. Godly sorrow produces repentance which leads to salvation. (2 Cor. 7:10).
